

## Louisiana Reining Horse Association Breeders Classic Breeding Contract

I hereby donate to Louisiana Reining Horse Association, a breeding to a designated mare by my stallion \_\_\_\_\_ for the breeding year \_\_\_\_\_.

This Louisiana Reining Horse Association (LRHA) contract is transferable to the mare owner who purchases the stallion service. This amount cannot be less than \$350 or 50% of the advertised service fee. A live foal is guaranteed only to the extent of one return the following year of the same mare or a substitute mare and then only by the initial owner of the contract. Further the mare owner, by participating in this Louisiana Reining Horse Association (LRHA) program, does understand, agree and accept that Louisiana Reining Horse Association members, officers, and representatives are not liable for death, sickness, and/or accidental injury including consequential damages to the mare, foal, or the mare owner during participation in this breeding program caused by either negligent or intentional acts of any party to the contract. The stallion owner's standard breeding contract will be signed indicating the donated breeding and sent to Louisiana Reining Horse Association (LRHA) so they will be familiar and have a record of the donation. If the stallion is sold or dies anytime before the donated obligation is met the donor of the stallion breeding must immediately notify the Louisiana Reining Horse Association president. If the stallion dies before the said donated breeding occurs to the purchaser, and no other comparable stallions are available to the purchaser, Louisiana Reining Horse Association will reimburse the purchaser, in full, the amount purchaser paid. If the stallion is sold before the obligation is met, the undersigned owner of the stallion at the time of donation must make arrangements with new owners of stallion to fulfill the obligation to purchaser, in writing and submitted to Louisiana Reining Horse Association and purchaser within 30 days of sale. If stallion owner does not comply, the undersigned stallion owner will be held liable for reimbursement of monies, in full, to the purchaser. The stallion owner will charge the mare owner for normal mare care charges and any other applicable charges such as chute fees, in-foal fees, veterinary fees, semen shipping fees, etc. These fees shall be the responsibility of the mare owner. Once the breeding has been sold, Louisiana Reining Horse Association (LRHA) will notify the breeding facility where the stallion is standing. The contact person's name and phone number of the breeding facility will be given to the purchaser. Breeding arrangements will be made between donor and purchaser. Louisiana Reining Horse Association is not responsible for booking dates or any additional fees associated with this breeding.

I have read this contract and I fully understand it and I agree to abide with all the provisions of this agreement.
